

BARD MUSIC FESTIVAL SCHUBERT AND HIS WORLD AUGUST 8-10, 2014

The mission of **THE BARD MUSIC FESTIVAL** is "to promote new ways of understanding the history of music to a contemporary audience." This summer, the festival will focus on the world of **FRANZ SCHUBERT (1797-1828).** We will be attending **WEEKEND ONE:** *The Making of a Romantic Legend.* Six concerts, each preceded by a pre-concert talk, will take place in the Frank Gehry-designed **RICHARD B. FRIDAY, AUGUST 8- Travel from Philadelphia to the HUDSON RIVER VALLEY. Enjoy a box lunch before arriving at BARD COLLEGE for an early afternoon tour of the RICHARD B FISHER CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS and the HESSEL MUSEUM OF ART at the distinguished Center for Curatorial Studies at Bard. Check into the COURTYARD BY MARRIOTT in Kingston. Dinner is included at MERCATO before returning to the Bard Campus for our first pre-concert talk and concert.

<u>SATURDAY</u>, <u>AUGUST 9</u> — Return to <u>BARD COLLEGE</u> this morning for a panel discussion on <u>INVENTION AND REINVENTION</u>: WHO WAS SCHUBERT? Two concerts are scheduled for today at 1 PM and again at 8 PM. At 5 PM, there is a special event, THE SONG CYCLE AS DRAMA: WINTERREISE. Food service between concerts is available at the <u>SPIEGELTENT</u> on the campus of Bard as well as in <u>OLIN HALL</u>.

<u>SUNDAY, AUGUST 10</u> – Three concert/discussions are on our agenda today at 10 AM, 1 PM and 5 PM. We depart Bard College after the final concert for our return trip to Philadelphia.

PLEASE NOTE: Six concerts and the special event **WINTERREISE** are included in the cost below. We realize that some of you might want to relax at the hotel (there is a fitness center and indoor pool) or enjoy some time in the charming town of **RHINEBECK** nearby. We will be most happy to deduct the cost of tickets for programs you do not wish to attend if you let us know at the time your final payment is due.

COST: \$1395 per person, double occupancy. The single supplement is \$220. The cost includes all transportation by deluxe motor coach, two nights at the COURTYARD BY MARRIOTT in Kingston, NY, tickets to all concerts (6) and pre-concert events and one special event, tour of the Fisher Center, guided tour at the Hessell Museum, one lunch, one dinner, and taxes on all included items. SPACE IS LIMITED to 24 participants. Please complete the coupon below and mail it with a deposit of \$450 to Excursions from the Square, P.O. Box 2189, Philadelphia, PA 19103. We accept Visa, MasterCard and American Express at a small additional charge. FINAL PAYMENT is due no later than Friday, June 6. 2014. Full refund may be made up to June 6 less an administrative fee of \$450. Thereafter, the cost of the trip is non-refundable unless a replacement is found. Trip cancellation insurance is available. The trip will be escorted by a representative from EXCURSIONS FROM THE SQUARE.
