

## **A WEEK IN PARIS MAY 2-9, 2016**

We are delighted to be returning to Paris this spring. If you have never been to the CITY OF LIGHT, or wish to return, this is the trip for you! Our always-spectacular EXCURSION to Paris will include comprehensive sightseeing as well as free time to wander on your own. We have included the city's grand monuments as well as an abundant sampling of her splendid museums. Special tours will give us an opportunity to enjoy the architecture, sculpture, parks and avenues of one of the world's most beautiful cities. A highlight will be a visit to the newly opened FOUNDATION LOUIS VUITTON, designed by American architect Frank Gehry. Optional evening events will be arranged to ensure you have the richest possible experience throughout your stay. Accommodations are at the wonderfully located HOTEL DU LOUVRE.

MONDAY, MAY 2 — Early evening departure from Philadelphia, or your home city, to Paris. Dinner and breakfast will be served aboard the airplane.

<u>TUESDAY, MAY 3</u> — Upon arrival at Charles de Gaulle Airport, transfer to the **HOTEL DU LOUVRE** conveniently located amid Paris' most exciting landmarks, museums and shops. Enjoy an orientation tour of the neighborhood this afternoon. Dinner is included this evening. **(B,D)** 

WEDNESDAY, MAY 4 — Our sightseeing this morning will include the great monuments of Paris: the PLACE DE LA CONCORDE, and stately TUILERIES GARDENS and the opulent PARIS OPERA HOUSE, designed in the Second Empire style by Charles Garnier. The bustling CHAMPS-ELYSÉES ends at the ARC DE TRIOMPHE that commemorates Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz. We will stop at the EIFFEL TOWER, centerpiece of the 1889 International Exposition, visit NAPOLEON'S TOMB and stroll through the magnificent LUXEMBOURG GARDENS in the heart of the Latin Quarter. This afternoon a visit is planned to ST. CHAPELLE, with its beautiful stained glass, and the great Gothic Cathedral of NOTRE DAME. (B)

THURSDAY, MAY 5 —This morning we will tour one the most beautiful areas of Paris, the 16<sup>th</sup> Arrondissement. We will visit the OLD VILLAGE OF PASSY, once a country village outside the city walls. Our guide will take us through streets famous for their ART NOUVEAU houses by Hector Guimard, designer of the distinctive Paris Metro entrances introduced at the turn of the twentieth century. This afternoon we will visit the MUSEE MARMOTTON MONET, housing a magnificent collection of paintings by Claude Monet and other impressionists, and the fabulous new FOUNDATION LOUIS VUITTON, a spectacular new museum of contemporary art designed by American architect Frank Gehry located in the BOIS DU BOULOGNE. (B)

FRIDAY, MAY 6 — Today is free to explore Paris on your own. CENTRE GEORGES POMPIDOU housing one of the most important collections of modern art in the world, and the ancient HOTEL DU CLUNY with its fine collection of French Medieval treasures is both open today. Or you might wish to do some shopping or take a public tour to VERSAILLES or CHARTRES. (B)

<u>SATURDAY, MAY 7</u> — This morning we have planned a walking tour which will include ST. GERMAIN and stately ST. SULPICE with its beautiful murals by Delacroix. You can enjoy lunch on the LEFT BANK and shop in the fabulous boutiques on the RUE BONAPARTE. Since we will be close by, we suggest a visit to the MUSÉE D'ORSAY, housed in a former train station and Paris' spectacular showcase for 19<sup>th</sup> century art and culture. It is an easy walk back to the HOTEL DU LOUVRE. (B,D)

SUNDAY, MAY 8 – Enjoy a morning walking tour in the charming MARAIS. Stroll around the PLACE DES VOSGES, the city's oldest square. At the PLACE DE LA BASTILLE we will recall the birthplace of the French Revolution in 1789. Lunch is included following our tour. In the afternoon you can visit the PICASSO MUSEUM, which contains the artist's collection of his own works and his personal collection of paintings by Matisse, Renoir, Braque and Rousseau; HOTEL CARNAVALET (historical Museum of the City of Paris), or the fascinating MUSEUM OF HISTORY AND ART OF JUDAISM. (B,L)

MONDAY MAY 9 – If you are returning home today we will make arrangements for you to return to the airport. Additional nights at the HOTEL DU LOUVRE are available upon request.

<u>TOUR COST</u>: The cost for land arrangements is **\$2625**. The single supplement is **\$795**. We will make every effort to arrange for a compatible roommate if you are interested.

<u>INCLUDED IN THE LAND PACKAGE:</u> Accommodations for six nights at the **HOTEL DU LOUVRE** including buffet breakfast, tax and service; one lunch, two dinners; sightseeing tours as listed in the itinerary, including museum admission costs; and a pre-trip reading packet. Airfare is additional. Airport transfers are not included. The trip will be escorted by a representative from **EXCURSIONS FROM THE SQUARE.**
