

MARLBORO MUSIC FESTIVAL AUGUST 11-15, 2016

We invite you, once again, to immerse yourself in an atmosphere of artistry and excellence at the **MARLBORO MUSIC FESTIVAL**. Each summer on a rural hilltop in Vermont, master concert artists join for seven weeks with exceptional young professionals on the campus of **MARLBORO COLLEGE** where they rehearse, study and play together as one musical family. We will enjoy the landscapes of New England, with its charming villages, country stores and museums. On our way home we have planned a special stop at Cooperstown for a performance of Sondheim's **SWEENEY TODD** at the innovative **GLIMMERGLASS OPERA**.

<u>THURSDAY, AUGUST 11</u> - Depart the Philadelphia area and travel north to Vermont. Enjoy a box lunch and a stop at the SMITH COLLEGE MUSEUM OF ART, one of the nation's finest college museums. In the late afternoon we will check in at the comfortable HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS in the heart of BRATTLEBORO. A welcome dinner is included this evening. (L,D)

FRIDAY, AUGUST 12 - Travel to WILLIAMSTOWN, MASSACHUSETTS, to the WILLIAMS COLLEGE MUSEUM OF ART and the STERLING AND FRANCINE CLARK ART INSTITUTE with its exciting new renovations by Pritzker Prize-winning architect Tadeo Ando. Dinner is included prior to our first evening concert at the MARLBORO MUSIC FESTIVAL. (B,D)

<u>SATURDAY, AUGUST 13</u> - This morning we will attend a rehearsal at MARLBORO. In the afternoon travel to HANOVER, NEW HAMPSHIRE, where you have the choice of visits either to the HOOD MUSEUM at DARTMOUTH COLLEGE or a visit to the AUGUSTUS ST. GAUDENS MEMORIAL in nearby CORNISH. Suggestions will be provided for dinner this evening prior to a pre-concert talk about the history of the MARLBORO MUSIC FESTIVAL and tonight's concert. (B)

<u>SUNDAY, AUGUST 14</u> - Sleep in this morning or enjoy some time in **BRATTLEBORO** where you can shop, enjoy a light lunch on your own and visit the exceptional **BRATTLEBORO MUSEUM** and **ART CENTER**. Return to **MARLBORO** in the afternoon for our final concert. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)

<u>MONDAY, AUGUST 15</u>- Travel to COOPERSTOWN, NEW YORK, where lunch is included at the fabulous OTESAGA HOTEL. You can choose between visits to the town's many museums, such as the NATIONAL BASEBALL HALL OF FAME, or the FENIMORE ART MUSEUM, or a performance of Stephen Sondheim's SWEENEY TODD at the renowned GLIMMERGLASS OPERA (\$118). We will make a stop for dinner on your own on the return trip to the Philadelphia area. (B,L)

INCLUDED FEATURES: Four nights' accommodations at the HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS ; tax and porterage; three dinners, two lunches, and full American Breakfast daily; all transportation by deluxe motor coach from the Philadelphia area; admission costs for included sightseeing; three chamber music concerts.
