

## SANTA FE AUGUST 14-20, 2015

Join us this summer for our **EXCURSION** to the **AMERICAN SOUTHWEST**. Spend six nights at the charming **INN ON THE ALAMEDA** and enjoy museums rich in the art and artifacts of the city's fascinating blend of Spanish, Indian and Anglo-American cultures. Excursions to **BANDELIER NATIONAL MONUMENT** and **ABIQUIU**, the former home of **GEORGIA O'KEEFFE** are also on the agenda. There will be ample time to browse in shops and galleries and dine in local restaurants featuring unique New Mexican dishes. In addition, we will assist you in getting tickets to the **SANTA FE OPERA** and **SANTA FE CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVAL**. We are offering an optional pre-trip to **ALBUQUERQUE**, which includes a visit to the **ACOMA PUEBLO** known for its beautiful pottery. There will also be an optional post-trip in **NORTHERN NEW MEXICO** with in depth touring in the area of **TAOS**, and evening concerts at **MUSIC FROM ANGEL FIRE**, a world-class chamber music festival in its 32<sup>nd</sup> season.

**FRIDAY, AUGUST 14--** Travel to Albuquerque and transfer by private motor coach to the charming **INN ON THE ALAMEDA.** We will enjoy a Welcome Dinner together this evening.

**SATURDAY, AUGUST 15** -- On a morning tour our guide will recreate the fascinating history of Santa Fe. We will see examples of Pueblo architecture as well as the jewels of modern sculpture that grace the public areas of the city. Included are the **PALACE OF THE GOVERNORS**; the **LORETTO CHAPEL**, with its legendary staircase; and the **ST. FRANCIS CATHEDRAL**, the dream of French bishop Jean-Baptiste Lamy as told in Willa Cather's <u>Death Comes to the Archbishop</u>. In the afternoon you are free to visit museums near Santa Fe's famed Plaza such as the **GEORGIA O'KEEFFE MUSEUM** and the **MUSEUM OF NEW MEXICO**.

OPTION: 8.30 PM - VIVALDI'S FOUR SEASONS AT THE SANTA FE CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVAL OPTION: 8.30 PM - RIGOLETTO by GUISEPPI VERDI AT THE SANTA FE OPERA.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 16 — On our schedule this morning is a stop at the widely respected SHIDONI SCULPTURE FOUNDRY, followed by a picnic lunch and tour at the BANDELIER NATIONAL MONUMENT. Before returning to Santa Fe, we will stop in LOS ALAMOS for a visit to the BRADBURY SCIENCE MUSEUM where exhibits document the dawning of the Atomic Age in the 1940s, and the less often visited LOS ALAMOS HISTORICAL MUSEUM, a fascinating venue full of photographs and artifacts of the decades prior to the MANHATTAN PROJECT.

OPTION: 6.00PM – MOZART AND BARTOK AT THE SANTA FE CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVAL.

MONDAY, AUGUST 17 -- Today is free and we have planned an optional trip to MUSEUM HILL, where you can visit the new MUSEUM OF SPANISH COLONIAL ART, the WHEELWRIGHT MUSEUM OF THE AMERICAN INDIAN, the MUSEUM OF INDIAN ARTS AND CULTURE and the MUSEUM OF INTERNATIONAL FOLK ART with its renowned Girard Collection of toys, dolls and masks from around the world. In the afternoon you might wish to take a class at the renowned SANTA FE SCHOOL OF COOKING, browse in the galleries and shops near the city's lively plaza, or have a relaxing massage at TEN THOUSAND WAVES.

OPTION: 8.30PM - COLD MOUNTAIN by JENNIFER HIGDON AT THE SANTA FE OPERA

**TUESDAY, AUGUST 18** -- Our morning plan is a visit to the **FENN GALLERY** with its treasures of early Western artists and its outdoor sculpture garden, and a walk up Canyon Road to browse in some of the most unusual art galleries in America. This afternoon we suggest an optional visit (\$95) to **ABIQUIU**, the former home of Georgia O'Keeffe, as well as her **GHOST RANCH**, and the magnificent landscapes that influenced her palate.

OPTION: SALOME by RICHARD STRAUSS AT THE SANTA FE OPERA

**WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 19** – Our last day in **SANTA FE** is free to revisit museums, galleries and shops or just relax and enjoy this extraordinary destination! A finale dinner is included this evening.

THURSDAY, AUGUST 20 -- Arrangements for return transportation to the ALBUQUERQUE airport will be made. Additional nights at the INN ON THE ALAMEDA are available upon request. Tonight there is a performance of DONIZETTI'S DAUGHTER OF THE REGIMENT, in case you might want to stay to see this opera. A late morning departure for TAOS is planned if you will be partaking in the MUSIC FROM ANGEL FIRE WEEKEND (see below).

We have suggested performances in the day-by-day itinerary and will assist you in obtaining tickets for all performances in the price range that is appropriate for you.
